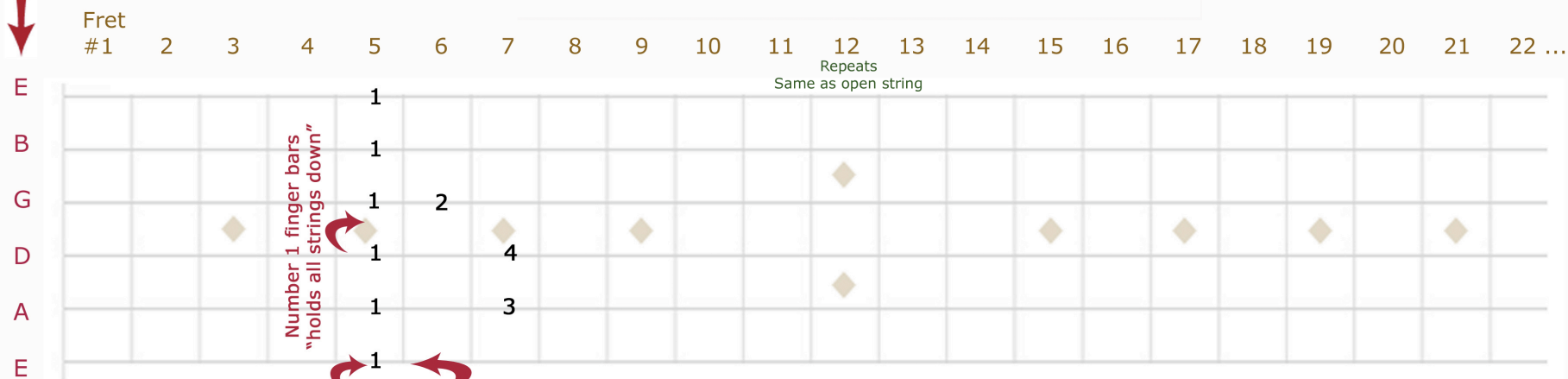


The A Power Chord Position

(this example in the key of A)

Confused? Watch the video one time!

Open String Note



Remember... Wherever your number one finger is in The A Power Chord Position (on the E string) tells you what key your playing in! This example is in the key of A. Slide everything forward 2 frets and it's in the key of B. Slide everything forward 3 frets and your number 1 finger is on the 10th fret and that tells us we're in the key of D. It doesn't get any easier.

Use the reference hand to the left to understand which fingers need to go on the neck of the guitar.

The example shown above is for "The A Power Chord Position".

Remember, we'll call this position The A Power Chord and it may be used in different keys!

The name is just to help you always know to hold your fingers in this position. You could hold the A Power Chord in the key of A,B,C, etc...

In other words we could have named it "The Funny Chord" and played it in various keys.

We just call it "The A Power Chord".
