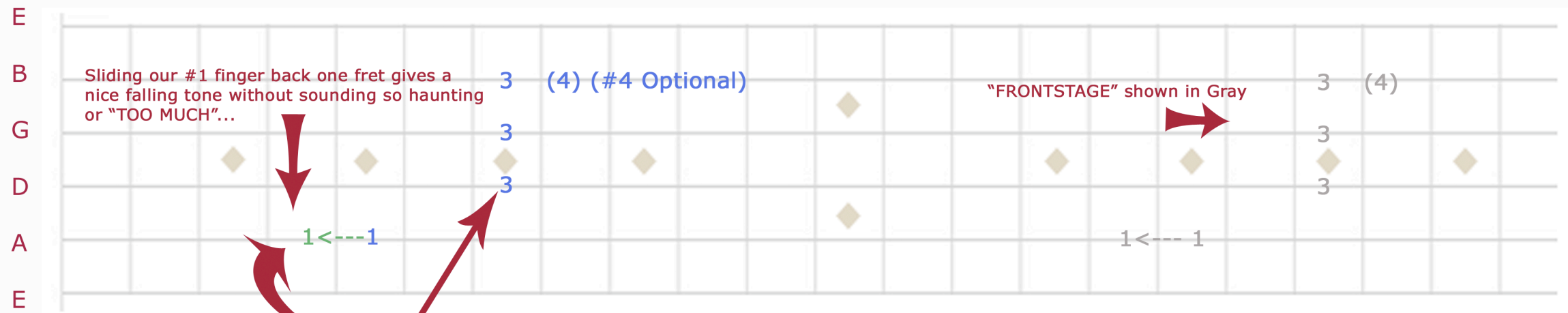
Confused? Watch the video one time!

Open String Note



Fret #1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 ...

REPEAT
Same as open



Sliding our #1 finger back one fret gives a nice falling tone without sounding so haunting or "TOO MUCH"...



Use the reference hand to the left to understand which fingers need to go on the neck of the guitar.



NOTE FROM JERRY IN THE STUDIO...

The blue notes make the typical D Power chord - notice the number four finger has been added as in the video

The green note indicates the note we slide back to that gives that nice soft falling tone. All other fingers stay in the same position.

Practice this in every KEY as you slide it up and down the neck. Apply "Front Stage" to this for some great new sounds out of a common chord.
