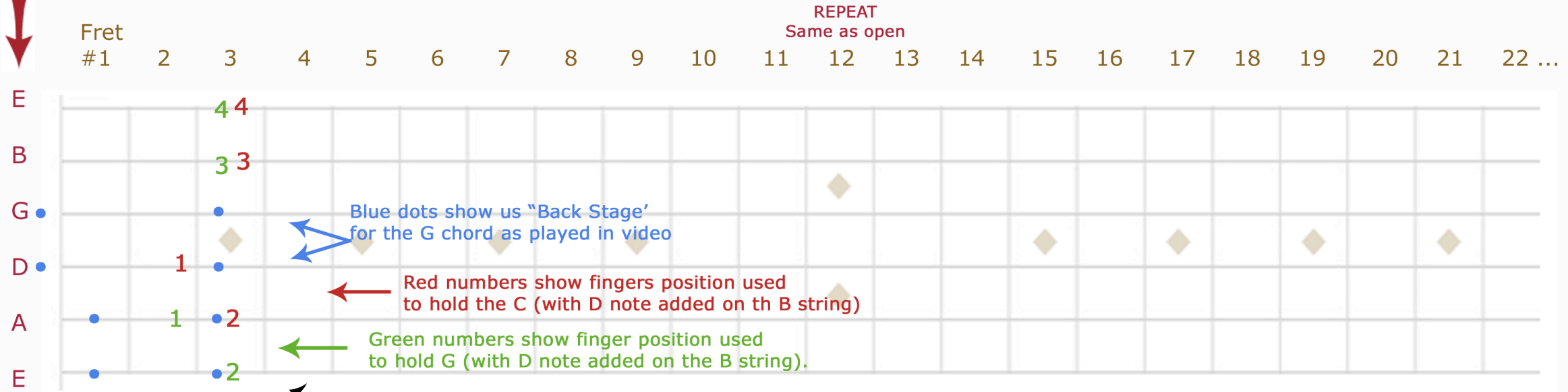

Confused? Watch the video one time!

Open String Note

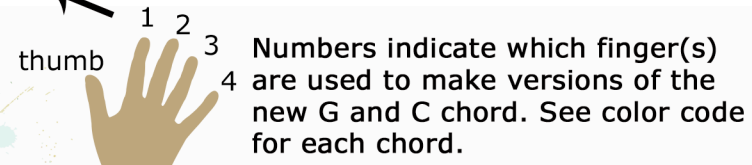


Blue dots show us "Back Stage" for the G chord as played in video

Red numbers show fingers position used to hold the C (with D note added on th B string)

Green numbers show finger position used to hold G (with D note added on the B string).

REPEAT
Same as open

NOTE FROM JERRY IN THE STUDIO...

IMPORTANT... To keep from getting confused by this illustration, look at the color codes. It's easy.

Look at the blue dots and read their blue note.

Next look at the Red #'s and read their red note.

Next look at the Green #'s and read their red note.

This is an excellent method for shifting from a G to a C chord with very little movement required.

It also provides and nice rich tone since the D is added on the B string.
