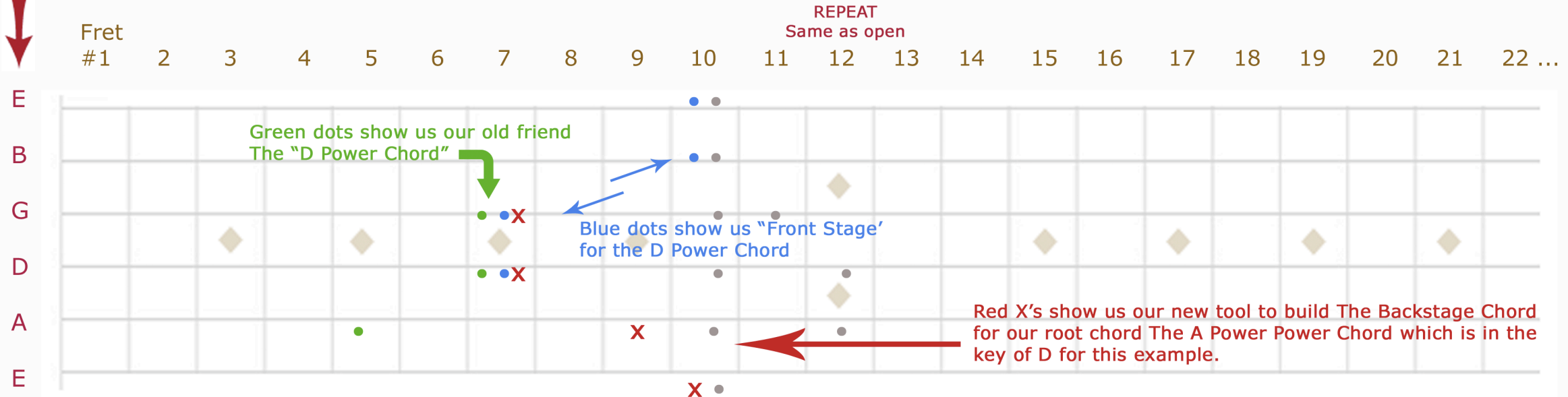


“The Powerchord Merge To Backstage”

The Backstage Chord To The A Powerchord - In the key of D

Confused? Watch the video one time!

Open String Note



Remember... Wherever your number one finger is in The D Power Chord Position (on the A string) tells you what key your playing in! This example is in the key of D.

Wherever the #1 is on the top string in the "A Power Chord" tells us what key we're in.

NOTE FROM JERRY IN THE STUDIO...

IMPORTANT... To keep from getting confused by this illustration, look at the green dots and read the green note.

Then look at the blue dots and read their blue note.

Next look at the Red X's and read their red note.

Also notice how our typical "A Power Chord" (shown as Gray DOTS) is sitting under all of this and setting all of this up for us automatically! This is very powerful!

Again - Don't let all of this BLEED together. Look at each color code to easily know what's-what.
