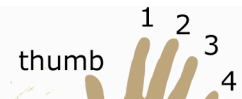
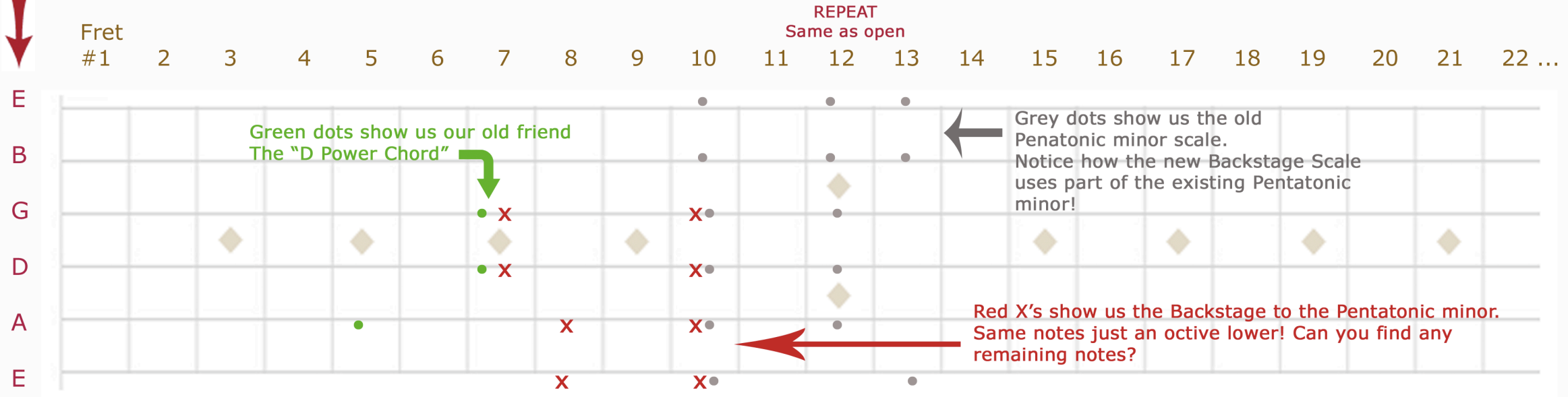


“The Powerchord Merge To Backstage”

The Backstage Scale To The A Powerchord - In the key of D

Confused? Watch the video one time!

Open String Note



Remember... Wherever your number one finger is in The D Power Chord Position (on the A string) tells you what key your playing in! This example is in the key of D.

Wherever the #1 is on the top string in the "A Power Chord" tells us what key we're in.

IMPORTANT... To keep from getting confused by this illustration, look at the green dots and read the green note.

Next look at the Red X's and read their red note.

Also notice where the standard Pentatonic is in relation to where the A Powerchord sits.

You are holding a big key to playig solos like wild!
