You can play the open G string on all of these two finger chord variations

- Play the red notes for the first new chord variation Don't forget the open D string in it!
- Play the green numbers for the second chord variation (of a C). Remember you can add the open G string to this as well!
- Play the purple numbers for the third chord variation (of a D). Remember you can add the open G string to this as well!
- Play the orange numbers for the second chord variation (of a E). Remember you can add the open G string to this as well! ADD THE OPEN E STRING TO THIS CHORD!
