Don't get too hung up on the sound of things when you first start doing this lesson.

The big “TAKE AWAY” on this lesson is to get yourself doing the Wicka-Chicka and getting used to keeping a beat going on in the background as you move around.

Slap the A & D blues Chords in between and just experiment.

You can do this very easily with minimal practice and once you get the hang of it you'll start seeing and hearing some unusual things in your playing.
