Confused? Watch the video one time!

Open String Note

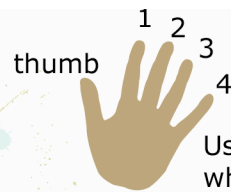
12th Fret Repeats Same as open

Notice The Orange Numbers... See Note At Bottom Right On This Blueprint.

Additional orange numbers tell you what order to play the strings

Know what that is? It's your "Triple Factor" for this lesson. Try it too! Play them, tap them, or touch them. Refer back to The Triple Factor if you get confused!

The DOTS in GREEN indicate the Pentatonic Scale.



Use the reference hand to help understand which fingers need to go on the neck of the guitar.

This lesson goes right along with what we learned in the Cowboy Blues 1 & 2 Lessons. It moves more towards the middle of the scale.

BLUE lines next to dots help you remember what strings that we "paired-up" to create that cool lick in the video. Play those two notes together.

Don't get hung up on reading this chart too much.

Orange Numbers tell you the order to play the string to get the lick we learned in the video.

A NUMBER BESIDE A DOT DOES NOT INDICATE THE FRET NUMBER LIKE TYPICAL GUITAR TAB!!!
 If you see the number 1 by a dot, that means to play that note first. A dot with the number 2 means play that note second, and so on and so on...

- Run through the lick and then repeat it over again and again.
