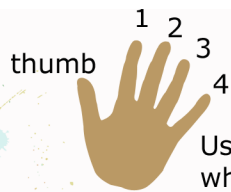
Remember... The red numbers (to the left) are just added notes to the basic Pentatonic Scale. They give it a blues sound and feel.

Additional orange notes make up the lick from the video!

Notice The Orange Stars! They are the optional notes played together for the lick in the video. Try it!

The numbers in GREEN indicate the basic Pentatonic Scale.

Know what that is? It's your "Triple Factor" for this lesson. Try it too! Play them, tap them, or touch them. Refer back to The Triple Factor if you get confused!



Use the reference hand to help understand which fingers need to go on the neck of the guitar.

This lesson goes right along with what we learned in the first Cowboy Blues Lesson. It just adds a few notes to create that cool little tune and lick we were playing in this lesson's video

You'll notice that there is a **BLUE** line next to some numbers.

This is to help you remember what strings that we "paired-up" to create that cool lick in the video. Play those two notes together.

Don't get hung up on reading this chart too much.

The orange stars (top left) are the added notes that create the tune we were playing. Remember, if they have a blue line beside them, that means to play those two notes together. Easy stuff!
